

Sunday Fellowship Host

This position can be fulfilled by one dedicated volunteer, or by a couple of people partnering together. The 9:30am—10:30am hour is a perfect time for fellowship among those who are not involved in a Sunday School. The host/hostess would be responsible to pick up donuts and/or other eats and have them available at this time on Sunday mornings. The host/hostess would also prepare coffee and ensure that the coffee area is stocked up and kept tidy. Additionally, this person would work to greet and create an atmosphere of good hospitality for everyone during the fellowship time.

Guest Follow-up Members

Enon Church works to ensure that our guests know how special and loved they are beyond their Sunday morning worship experience. In order to achieve this, we have to be intentional about reaching out to our guests several times after their first visit. This ministry focuses on ensuring that guests get welcome gifts at their first visit. Then, based upon the information shared on a Connect Card, we will continue to reach out to them by email, text, or even a personal gift. All these are simple ways to show God's love to guests. In order to minister in this way consistently, we need a team dedicated to following up with each guest God blesses us with. There is a great need right now for someone to coordinate and lead this ministry. Training is available for anyone joining this great team.

Celebration Place Workers

Enon's Celebrate Recovery on Friday nights is the only recovery program that offers ministry to children as well. This is not simply a babysitting or childcare position. Celebration Place is designed to proactively teach the children of recovering adults in a way that will help them resist falling into the same struggles their loved ones have faced. It is a discipleship program for the children who come on Friday nights.

CR Landing Workers

In the same way that we are encouraged to work the Christ Centered 12 steps on Friday night in Celebrate Recovery, we also have curriculum for the teens. Teens are at an age where peer pressure and conformity to the world is a huge concern. The risk involved is even higher if a teen comes from a home that is familiar with the need for recovery. This program is designed to help the teens figure out the process of recovery that their family members are going through and to be equipped to choose a better path for themselves. We are in need of people willing to invest in the teens and use the curriculum to strengthen them on Friday nights at Celebrate Recovery.

Fellowship Event Planner

The calendar gets filled up with events quickly! There are several fellowship events that take place in the life of the church. There is a great need for someone to take on the responsibility of pulling these events together. This doesn't mean that the planner will have to do all the work; these events will require recruiting a team for help or putting together a sign-up sheet so others can get involved. Some of the annual events include the Harvest Party, Friend Day meal, and Easter meal. If you are a good planner and love to put an event together, let us know by putting this service role on your Connect Card attached to the Sunday morning bulletin.

Outreach Event Planner

There is always a need for the Body of Christ to be active in the community. This person would be responsible for planning, communicating and pulling together the many details involved in going out and being the hands and feet of Christ in our neighborhoods. Working together with the Growth Groups provides a great opportunity to brainstorm and fulfill service projects. Coordination with other groups and organizations (schools, community efforts, fund raising and awareness efforts) is encouraged. Pray and ask God if this is the role you can render to Him for the advancement of the Gospel.


